

INTERVIEW WITH STUDENT COUNCIL PRESIDENT (ENG)

Editorial office: How do you feel as a student council president?

Zuzanna: It seems that only just now I feel that I am the president. Mostly because something finally starts to happen and therefore, I have to make a lot of decisions. I think that it is a very big responsibility.

Editorial office: Why did you take part in the election?

Zuzanna: Mostly experience. I was the class president for two years, I participated in many student council meetings and I saw student council presidents work, so I wanted to try this role myself.

Editorial office: How can you influence the school?

Zuzanna: I want to focus on bringing unity to the school community. Despite the competitiveness with each other, I would like to create a relatively friendly atmosphere where everyone can rely on each other.

<u>Editorial office:</u> What makes you different from other candidates?

Zuzanna: It seems that other contestant focused on straight facts and plans. I think the main difference between us was that I wanted to listen to everyone and respond to their needs. My point was a free conversation, I don't want to create an authoritarian system.

Editorial office: Do you think you will last?

Zuzanna: I think I will. I believe I'm a good leader. I'm a good student and I'm engaged in everything I do.

I think I will last because I have the predisposition to do so.

INTERVIEW WITH STUDENT COUNCIL PRESIDENT (PL)

Redakcja: Jak się czujesz w roli przewodniczącej?

Zuzanna: Mam wrażenie, że dopiero teraz czuję, że jestem przewodniczącą. Przede wszystkim dlatego, że w końcu zaczyna się coś dziać i w związku z tym muszę podejmować wiele decyzji. Wydaje mi się, że to bardzo duża odpowiedzialność.

Redakcja: Co skłoniło Cię do wzięcia udziału w wyborach? Zuzanna: Przede wszystkim doświadczenie. Byłam przewodniczącą klasy przez dwa lata, uczestniczyłam w obradach samorządu i miałam do czynienia z wieloma przewodniczącymi, więc sama chciałam spróbować swoich sił w tej roli.

Redakcja: Co myślisz, że możesz wnieść do szkoły?

Zuzanna: Chcę skupić się na wniesieniu jedności społeczności szkolnej. Pomimo wszechobecnego konkurowania i porównywania się ze sobą, chciałabym stworzyć w miarę przyjazną atmosferę, gdzie każdy może na sobie polegać.

Redakcja: Co wyróżnia Cię od innych kandydatów?
Zuzanna: Wydaje mi się, że moja konkurentka skupiła się na zaproponowaniu konkretnych założeń. Myślę, że to była głównie ta różnica, że chciałam wysłuchać wszystkich i odpowiedzieć na ich potrzeby. Chodziło mi o to, aby to była wolna rozmowa, nie chcę tworzyć autorytarnego systemu.

Redakcja: Czy myślisz, że podołasz tej funkcji?

Zuzanna: Sądzę, że podołam. Myślę, że jestem raczej dobrym liderem. Bardzo dobrze sprawuję się w szkole i jestem zaangażowana we wszystkie projekty. Mam wrażenie, że podołam gdyż mam do tego predyspozycje.

INTERVIEW WITH STUDENT COUNCIL VICE PRESIDENT (ENG)
